

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-02

AN ORDINANCE OF HOP BOTTOM BOROUGH,
SUSQUEHANNA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ADOPTING
THE BUDGET FOR THE 2013 CALENDAR YEAR,
AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES AND LEVYING TAXES

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of Hop Bottom Borough,
Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the
same:

SECTION 1. The Budget for the calendar year 2013, as prepared by the Borough,
including anticipated receipts and expenditures as set forth therein, is hereby approved and
adopted.

SECTION 2. A tax is hereby levied and assessed upon all real estate and occupation within the
Borough of assessed valuation for the calendar year 2012.

Tax rate for general purposes, the sum of 7.32 mills
on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

For Fire Protection purposes, the sum of 1.00 mills
for each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

For Occupational purposes, the sum of27.00 mills
for each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

Total35.32 mills


SECTION 3. The rate of discount for payment of taxes assessed by the Township shall
be two per centum from the amount of such tax upon making payment of the whole amount thereof within two months after the date
of the tax notice.

SECTION 4. All taxpayers who shall fail payment of any such taxes charged against
them after the date of the tax notice, shall be charged a penalty of which penalty shall be added to the taxes by the tax collector and
be collected by him.

SECTION 5. References are also made to the following taxes previously enacted by said
Borough under the authority of the Local Tax Enabling Act, of December 31, 1965, P.L. 1257,
as amended 53 P.S. 6901, et. seq. which are continued without change for the year 2013:

Earned Income Tax
Real Estate Transfer Tax
