AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ERECTION OF ANY STRUCTURE OR MOBILE HOME IN THE TOWNSHIP OF CHOCONUT WITHIN SEVENTY-FIVE (75) FEET FROM THE CENTER OF ANY ROAD.
BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of Choconut, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania as follows:
SECTION ONE: No person, partnership, business or corporation shall erect any building or shall place any mobile home within seventy-five (75) feet from the center of any road in the Township of Choconut, be it a township road or a state road.
SECTION TWO: Any person, partnership, business or corporation violating the terms of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction before a District Justice be sentenced to pay a fine of Fifty and 00/100 (\$50.00) Dollars for each day in violation and costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment of such fine and costs to imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than five (5) days for each violation.
SECTION THREE: In addition to the penalties set forth in Section Two hereof, the Township may bring action in a Court of Equity to obtain an injunction to restrain any person, partnership, business or corporation from violating this Ordinance.
SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after adoption.
