ORDINANCE

An Ordinance of the Township of Gibson establishing the requirements for the acceptance of additional roads within the Township of Gibson for maintenance by the Township of Gibson where persons desire the Township to accept the dedication of said roads.

The Township of Gibson hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

FIRST: No street, road or highway shall be adopted as a street, road or highway within the Gibson Township system of streets, roads and highways unless the right of way to be dedicated or laid out shall be at least fifty (50) feet in width throughout, and be surfaced prior to dedication with a hard surface to be at least twenty (20) feet in width throughout with eight (8) inches of rolled crushed gravel with proper grade berms and drainage.

SECOND: In case of a dead end street or road, there must be sufficient room at the end to turn a truck or grader around.

THIRD: The Township of Supervisors reserve the right to accept or reject any road, street or highway even with the above minimum requirements.

FOURTH: Prior to dedicating any street, road or highway in Gibson Township the Township Supervisors should approve the plans for said road, street or highway.

FIFTH: Any other requirements of the Second Class Township code must be complied with.

SIXTH: Calcium or a Penn Dot approved type of dust control must be maintained on said street, road or highway.
