

ORDINANCE NO. 133

ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A RECREATION BOARD FOR THE BOROUGH OF NEW MILFORD

(1) Creation; statutory authority; (2) Membership; (3) Appointments; terms of office; (4) Vacancies; (5) Duties of board; (6) Compensation; (7) General responsibilities; and (8) Obligations or expenditures.

The Borough of New Milford hereby enacts and ordains;

1. Creation; statutory authority.

A Recreation Board is hereby created, established and restructured in and for the Borough of New Milford in accordance with the provisions of Article XXVII of the Borough code as set forth by the Act of 1966, February 1, P.L. (1965)-No. 581, Sections 2708-2710, said Board to be known as the New Milford Recreation Board.

2. Membership.

The Recreation Board shall consist of five (5) persons who shall be residents of the Borough of New Milford.

3. Appointments; terms of office.

The members of the Recreation Board shall be appointed by the Borough Council and shall serve for terms of five (5) years or until their successors are appointed, except that the members of such Board first appointed shall be appointed as follows: two members (2) for one (1) year, two (2) members for two (2) years, three (3) members for three (3) years, and two (2) members for four (4) years.

4. Vacancies

Vacancies in the Recreation Board arising by expiration of a term, removal from the Borough or otherwise shall be filled by the Borough Council as provided by law. If any member of the Recreation Board, without sufficient cause or without having been excused from attendance by the Recreation Board, shall fail to attend the stated meetings of the Recreation Board for a period of three (3) consecutive months, he shall be considered to have withdrawn from membership on the Recreation Board and the Borough Council shall proceed to fill the vacancy thus created.
