

ORDINANCE NO. 27

An ordinance designating certain streets in the Borough of New Milford as main traveled or through highways.

Be it ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of New Milford, County of Susquehanna and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained by authority of the same that Main and Summit Streets in said Borough are hereby designated as main traveled or through highways. Be it further ordained that all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed. Adopted at a regular meeting of the Council of the Borough of New Milford aforesaid, held on the second day of March, A.D. 1928.
