## ORDINANCE NO. 160-11-1-12

AN ORDINANCE PF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW MILFORD, SUSQUEHANNA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 6 OF ORDINANCE NO. 160 OF NEW MILFORD BOROUGH JUNKYARD ORDINANCE.

**BE IT ORDAINED AN ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of New Milford, County of Susquehanna, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in regular meeting assembled that:

**WHEREAS**, the following amendment shall be made to Section 6 of Ordinance No. 160, Junkyard Ordinance:

The Codes Enforcement Officer of the Borough of New Milford, upon receipt of an application for permit under this Ordinance, shall determine whether or not a permit shall be issued, or a renewal thereof, shall be granted after an examination of the application, and upon the fullest consideration of the suitability of the premises proposed to be used for the purposes of the permit, the character of the property adjacent thereto, and the effect of the proposed use, taking into consideration the health, welfare, and safety of the residents of the Borough of New Milford and any potential hazard which may result to adjacent properties and structures thereon, to the citizens of New Milford Borough. Upon approval of the application for permit, the Codes Enforcement Officer of New Milford Borough shall issue the applicant a permit, upon which shall, at all times, be conspicuously posted upon the premises thereunder covered by said permit. No such permit issued by the Codes Enforcement Officer shall be transferable or assignable by Agreement, Will, Intestacy or otherwise.

**Repealer.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent with the terms hereof are hereby repealed.

**Severability.** If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part other than that part specifically declared invalid.
