

**ORDINANCE**

NO. 92-6

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ERECTION AND ENFORCEMENT OF NO PARKING SIGNS WITHIN THE BOROUGH.

The Borough of Hop Bottom hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION I: No parking signs shall be erected east of Railroad Street between US Route 11 and Glenwood Street.

SECTION II: The owner of any vehicle parked in the location specified in Section I of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$150.00 for each day or part of a day that the vehicle is parked. The owner of such vehicle shall also pay any towing charges incurred for having the vehicle removed. Each day or part of a day that the vehicle is parked in this area shall constitute a separate violation.

SECTION III: Moving of the vehicle from one place to another on the same day and within the area specified by this ordinance shall constitute two separate violations subject to two separate fines.
