

Ordinance no 1

PROHIBITION OF ACCUMULATION AND  
DUMPING OF GARBAGE AND REFUSE

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ACCUMULATION OR DUMPING  
OF GARBAGE AND REFUSE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF APOLACON  
AND THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF PUBLIC OR  
PRIVATE DUMPS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE SAID TOWNSHIP,  
AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

THE SUPERVISORS OF APOLACON TOWNSHIP, SUSQUEHANNA COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

No person, association, firm or corporation shall keep or  
suffer to remain upon his or her premises, or on any private  
property, any garbage, offal, carcass, putrid matter or other  
offensive or unwholesome matter, or cast the same upon any  
lot or piece of ground within the Township of Apolacon. Nor  
may any person, firm or corporation use or permit to be used  
any spot or place within the Township as a public or private  
dump for garbage, refuse or rubbish. Any person, firm or  
corporation who or which shall violate any of the provisions  
of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced  
to pay a fine of not more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)  
and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such  
fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days.  
PROVIDED: EACH DAY'S CONTINUANCE OF A VIOLATION SHALL CONSTI-  
TUTE A SEPARATE OFFENSE.
