SNOW/PARKING ORDINANCE 4287

Ordinance 4287 is hereby revised to add the following:

Section 2 (a) On all other streets except as stated in Sections 1 and 2, no parking shall be allowed on any Borough street for forty-eight hours after a snow fall of three inches or more during a twenty-four hour period of time in order to allow the Borough public works department time to remove the snow from the streets.

The fine schedule shall be amended to be \$50.00 for the first offense, \$100.00 for the second offense and \$200.00 for three or more offenses.

The Mayor and Borough Council President shall have the authority to have vehicles violating the terms of this amended ordinance towed at the vehicle owner's expense.

The Borough police and Pennsylvania State Police shall have the right to enforce this ordinance.

Except as amended the balance of Ordinance 4287 is left as if more fully set forth herein.
