

ORDINANCE NO. 78

An Ordinance of the Borough of New Milford, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania, fixing maximum weights and load limits for vehicles on Borough Streets.

The Borough of New Milford, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1

Words and phrases when used in this ordinance shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania as now in force, or as hereafter amended, enacted or reenacted, except on those instances where the context clearly indicates a different meaning. The singular shall include the plural and the masculine shall include the feminine..

SECTION 2

The maximum weight of vehicle and load on all Borough Streets except as hereafter set forth is hereby limited to seven (7) tons gross weight. Streets excepted from the foregoing provisions are:

Main Street and Route 11

Jackson Street

Susquehanna Street

Montrose Street

SECTION 3

Any person who shall operate a vehicle on any street or portion thereof, in violation of Sections 1 and 2 of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Two Dollars (\$2.00) or more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than five (5) days.
