

**ORDINANCE**

NO. 92-5

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OWNERS, CUSTODIANS, AND KEEPERS OF DOGS FROM ALLOWING SUCH DOGS TO RUN AT LARGE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

The Borough of Hop Bottom hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION I: It shall be unlawful for the owner, custodian, or keeper of any dog to allow such dog to run at large at any time, either upon any of the streets, alleys, or sidewalks in the Borough of Hop Bottom or upon the property of any other than the owner, custodian, or keeper of such dog, unless the dog is on a leash and accompanied by such owner, custodian, or keeper. Such owner, custodian, or keeper will clean up behind the dog with a "pooper scooper" or similar device.

SECTION II: Any owner, custodian, or keeper of any dog who shall violate any of the provisions of Section I of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$300 plus costs of prosecution and any costs of restitution for any property damage done by such dog. In default of payment of such costs, said owner, custodian, or keeper shall be sentenced to imprisonment for not more than thirty days. This ordinance shall be in addition to the Pennsylvania State Code.
