ORDINANCE NO. 23

An ordinance prohibiting the erection, insertion or location of a gas or oil tank or pump along the limits of any of the streets, lanes or alleys in the Borough of New Milford, Pennsylvania. Be it ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of New Milford, County of Susquehanna, and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained by authority of the same:

Section 1 That hereafter no gas or oil tank, pump or other structure for the purpose of distributing gas or oil shall be erected within the limits of any street lane or alley in the Borough of New Milford, Pennsylvania except as may be authorized, and a permit issued, by the Borough Council or a committee duly appointed by authority of the same, and provided that any such permit when and if issued shall be subject to existing State or Borough regulations relating thereto.

Section 2 That no gas or oil tank, pump or other structure for the purpose of distributing gas or oil shall be erected in the Borough of New Milford, Pennsylvania, where the service thereof shall obstruct the ordinary course of traffic along any street, lane or alley in said Borough, nor shall any permit be issued where such obstruction to traffic may occur.

Section 3 That the erection, insertion or location of any gas or oil tank or other structure for the distribution of gas or oil within the limits of any street, lane or alley in the said Borough of New Milford not in accordance herewith is hereby declared a nuisance and may be forthwith abated as such.

Ordained and enacted at a regular meeting of the Council of New Milford Borough, Pa. held on the 10th day of April, A.D. 1926.
