

ORDINANCE 2012-11

An Ordinance of Bridgewater Township establishing a procedure for setting of real property and special tax levies rates as ascertained by the last adjusted resolution for county purposes specified in the Second Class Township Code (2003 edition Section 3205) currently includes:

- Street lights
- Fire hydrants
- Equipment tax
- General Township purposes

Be it enacted and ordained, and it hereby is enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Bridgewater Township.

Title

Section 1: This ordinance shall be known as the Bridgewater Township Establishment of Tax Rates.

Section 2: All taxes based on real property valuations, and/or frontage feet shall be set by resolution.

Section 3: Collection. The annual assessment for real property and special taxes shall be collected by the tax collector in the same manner as township real estate taxes are collected, and if such assessment is uncollected the same shall be a lien and shall be collectible in the same manner as other municipal claims. The assessment shall be billed on the annual real estate bill for general purposes.

Section 4: Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5: Severability. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of Bridgewater Township that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.
