Opening and laying out streets in the Borough of New Milford.

The Borough of New Milford, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania hereby ordains as follows:

1. That a street to be called and known as Weterans Drive is hereby accepted, opened and laid out in said Borough in conformance with Release and Dedication of Trail, Post 383, Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States Home and Club Accociation, same being recorded in Deed Book 236, Page 304, said street is to be of a width of thirty three (33) feet and to extend from the old Lackawanna Trail to land of Jackson Brothers being more fully decribed on a Map of New Milford American Veterans Development of Lots duly recorded in Deed Book 234, Page 406.

- 2. That a street to be called and known as Union Street extension is hereby accepted, opened and laid out in said Borough in Conformance with Release and Dedication dated November 4, 1952 from Vincent Stanton and others which is to be recorded, said street is to start at the east end of the pavement on Union Street; thence east 700 feet with a width 22 feet throughout, said extension of Union Street being shown on Section "B" Subdivision of lands of Robert Mitchell, same being duly recorded in the Recorder's Office of Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania to which map reference may be had in Deed Book 151m page 373.
- 3. That a street to be called and known as Mitchell Street is hereby accepted, opened and laid out in conformance with Release and Dedication executed by Robert T. Mitchell and others which is to be recorded. Said street is to be of width of thirty seven (37) feet and is to run from Church Street easterly 740 feet and being fully set out on map of Subdivision "A" of Margaret M. Mitchell and Robert T. Mitchell which is recorded.

 4. That a street to be called and known as Cobb Avenue is hereby accepted, opened and laid out in conformance with release and dedication executed by Faith A. Cobb and others which is to be recorded. Said street is to be of a width of 30 feet and is to run from Route 11 westerly to the old D.L.&W. Railroad right of way and be of a width said street is to include all of Cobb Avenue as shown on map of lots of Faith Cobb being recorded in Deed Book 231, Page 34 together with a strip ten (10) feet in width from the northerly edge of lots 8, 15, 14, and 13 on said map.
