

BOROUGH OF FOREST CITY
ORDINANCE NO. 487 OF 2012

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 481 OF 2010 OF
THE BOROUGH OF FOREST CITY REGULATING THE
MAINTENANCE OF JUNKED MOTOR VEHICLES AND
ACCESSORIES WITHIN THE BOROUGH AND PROVIDING
FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Section 2. Definitions. Subsection a) sets forth;

Section 2. Definitions. For purposes of this Ordinance the following definitions shall be applicable:

a) Junked motor vehicle means a motor vehicle or trailer which is partially dismantled, unused, unusable or wrecked **and** which cannot safely or legally be operated on the streets or highways of this Borough or Commonwealth. Currently licensed, registered and inspected vehicles shall not be included within this definition. (Emphasis added).

WHEREAS, Borough Council of the Borough of Forest City desires to change said section to reflect that all motor vehicles which cannot be safely or legally operated on the streets of this Borough or Commonwealth meet the definition of Junked cars;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED and **IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by Borough Council of the Borough of Forest City, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania, that said section is amended to read as follows:


Section 2. Definitions. For purposes of this Ordinance the following definitions shall be applicable:

a) Junked motor vehicle means a motor vehicle or trailer which is partially dismantled, unused, unusable or wrecked or which cannot safely or legally be operated on the streets or highways of this Borough or Commonwealth.
