TAX ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. ____

BOROUGH OF NEW MILFORD

County of Susquehanna, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fixing the tax rate for fire protection and street lights for the year 1990.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Borough Council of the Borough of New Milford, County of Susquehanna, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all real property within the Borough subject to taxation for the year 1990 as follows:

For Fire Protection purposes, the sum of..... 2 mills
on each dollar of assessed valuation.

For Street Light purposes, the sum of..... 3 mills
on each dollar of assessed valuation.


Said taxes to be collected according to law by the Tax Collector of the Borough of New Milford and the Tax Claim Bureau of the County of Susquehanna, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as provided by law.

These taxes are levied pursuant to 53 P.S. § 46302, (6) and (4) respectively.

That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affect this ordinance.


