

## DEFACING PROPERTY Ordinance #43

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARFORD,  
SUSQUEHANNA COUNTY ON DEFACING PUBLIC AND PRIVATE  
PROPERTY.

A. Intent: It shall be unlawful for any person, partnership, corporation or agent acting independently or under the direction of the principal to deface any private or public buildings, structures, signs, banners, or vehicles within the Township.

B. Examples of Defacing: Defacing shall include but not be limited to the following examples:

1. Application of paint, inks and dyes.
2. Affixing of any printed materials such as signs or posters.
3. Destruction or removal.
4. Defacing in any manner.

C. Penalty: Anyone who defaces public or private property will be subject to a fine not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) plus the cost of repair and/or replacement plus the cost of installation. Each occurrence will constitute a separate offense.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days from the date of adoption.
