

ORDINANCE

NO. 92-7

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ERECTION AND ENFORCEMENT OF STOP SIGNS WITHIN THE BOROUGH.

The Borough of Hop Bottom hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION I: Stop signs shall be erected at the following locations within the Borough of Hop Bottom:

- A. At the intersection of Railroad Street and Glenwood Street traveling in a northerly direction on Railroad Street.
- B. At the intersection of Railroad Street and Glenwood Street traveling in a southerly direction on Railroad Street.
- C. At the intersection of Adams Street and Main Street traveling in a northerly direction on Adams Street.

SECTION II: Any operator of any vehicle or any pedestrian who does damage to any sign owned by the Borough of Hop Bottom shall make full restitution for the cost of a new sign including the cost of having it installed. In addition, such operator of the vehicle or such pedestrian shall pay a fine of \$100.

SECTION III: The operator of any vehicle failing to come to a complete stop at any of the locations specified in Section I of this ordinance shall be subject to the same fines and penalties as prescribed in the Motor Vehicle Code of the State of Pennsylvania.
