

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW MILFORD PROHIBITING  
PARKING ON THE WEST SIDE OF MAIN STREET IN THE BOROUGH  
AND PARKING OF THE EAST SIDE OF MAIN STREET IN THE BOROUGH.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF NEW MILFORD:

Section I. That the definitions contained in the "Vehicle  
Code" of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania shall apply to  
this ordinance.

Section II. That effective April 5, 1984, it shall be unlawful  
for any person to park any vehicle on the West side of Main Street  
in said Borough of New Milford between Montrose Street and  
Lackawanna St. and that effective April 5, 1984, it shall be  
unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on the East side  
of Main Street in said Borough of New Milford between Jackson  
Street and Wall Street.

Section III. Any person violating any provisions of this Ordinance  
shall, upon conviction thereof before any District Magistrate  
of Justice of the Peace in a summary proceedings, be liable to  
the payment of a fine of not more than ten dollars (\$10.00) and  
not less than two dollars (\$2.00) together with costs of pro-  
secution, and in default thereof to undergo imprisonment in the  
county Jail for not more than five (5) days.
