

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FOUR STOP SIGNS

ORDINANCE NO. 24

WHEREAS the Township of Thompson is responsible for the safety of the roadways throughout the Township; and

WHEREAS the Township of Thompson has determined there is a need for traffic control devices at or near the intersections of Callender and Lamb Roads, situate in the Township; and

WHEREAS the Township has determined that a present and hazardous condition exists at that same location; and

WHEREAS the Township has determined that by the addition of traffic control devices in the form of stop signs, the existing hazard can be reduced.

NOW THEREFORE, the Township does hereby ordain the placement of the following stop signs:

1. A stop sign shall be placed at the intersection of Callender and Lamb Roads, such as to stop the traffic from traveling in a southerly direction prior to said motorists either proceeding southerly on Callender Road or proceeding westerly on Lamb Road.
2. A stop sign shall be placed at the intersection of Callender and Lamb Road, such as to stop the traffic from proceeding in a northerly direction on Callender Road prior to said traffic entering Callender Road from Lamb Road.

3. A stop sign shall be placed 175 feet from the intersection of Callender Road with Lamb Road, such as to stop traffic proceeding in an Easterly direction towards Callender Road at the intersection of Lamb Road and a small dirt road connecting Lamb Road and Callender Road.

4. A stop sign shall be placed at the intersection of Lamb Road and Callender Road, such as to stop said traffic from Lamb Road at it's intersection with Callender Road and to control traffic entering Callender Road from Lamb Road.

AS thus ordained, the above captioned ordinance having been duly moved and seconded, it is hereby enacted this the 5th day of August, 2000.
