

ORDINANCE NO. 458

VACATING A PORTION OF SECOND STREET A/K/A SECOND AVENUE


THE BOROUGH OF SUSQUEHANNA DEPOT

SUSQUEHANNA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

Be it hereby ordained and enacted by the Borough of Susquehanna Depot, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania, that from and after the effective date of the within ordinance, which shall be forty days after the passage hereof, the portion of Second Street a/k/a Second Avenue described as follows, shall be deemed vacated:

1. Second Street, a/k/a Second Avenue, beginning at a point being the intersection of the Northerly line of Prospect Street formerly known as "C" Street and the Westerly line of Second Street a/k/a Second Avenue, thence continuing North along the Westerly line of said Second Street a/k/a Second Avenue a distance of two hundred and forty feet (240') along premises of Ackley to the Southerly line of Washington Street formerly "B" Street at its intersection with Second Street a/k/a Second Avenue, thence Easterly across Second Street a/k/a Second Avenue on a course perpendicular to its Westerly line a distance of approximately fifty feet (50') to a point at the intersection of the Southerly line of Washington Street with the Easterly line of Second Street a/k/a Second Avenue, thence Southerly on a perpendicular course along the Easterly line of Second Street a/k/a Second Avenue and premises of Troup a distance of two hundred forty feet (240') to a point at the intersection of the Northerly line of Prospect Street with the Easterly line of Second Street a/k/a Second Avenue, thence Westerly along the Northerly line of Prospect Street at a distance of fifty feet (50') to the point or place of beginning for the full width of fifty feet (50') of said Second Street a/k/a Second Avenue.



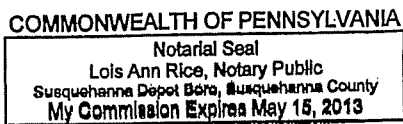

NOTICE OF VACATION OF A PORTION OF SECOND STREET a/k/a SECOND AVENUE BOROUGH OF SUSQUEHANNA DEPOT

You are hereby notified that on August 25, 2009, the Council of Borough of Susquehanna adopted Ordinance No. 459 vacating a portion of Second Street a/k/a Second Avenue in the Borough of Susquehanna Depot that portion of Second Street a/k/a Second Avenue between Washington Street and Prospect Street for a width of approximately 50 feet and extending a length of 240 feet. You are further notified that this Ordinance shall become effective forty (40) days after the date of this enactment, October 5, 2009. You are further notified that should you have any objections to said Ordinance, you may, during said forty (40) days period petition the Borough Council of the Borough of Susquehanna Depot for a Hearing which Council shall hold within thirty (30) days after the date of such Petition.

Whereas: On August 25, 2009, Ordinance was adopted for the Vacating of 2nd Avenue using Ordinance #458 due to typographical error.


