

ORDINANCE NO. 29

Officially recognizing the Fireman's Relief Association of Columbia Hose Company No. 1, New Milford, Pennsylvania and making certain appropriations thereto.

Section 1 Be it ordained and enacted by the Borough Council of the Borough of New Milford and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same that the Fireman's Relief Association of Columbia Hose Company No. 1, New Milford, Pennsylvania, be and it is hereby officially recognized by the Borough Council of the Borough of New Milford as an organization formed for the purpose of maintaining an association for beneficial and protector purposes, to its members and their families in case of death, sickness, temporary or permanent disability or accident from the funds collected therein.

Section 2 That the aforesaid Fireman's Relief Association of Columbia Hose Company No.1, be and it is hereby designated by the Borough Council of the Borough of New Milford as the proper association to receive such funds as are due and payable to the Borough Treasury by the Treasurer of the State of Pennsylvania, from the two per centum tax or premiums from foreign fire insurance companies.

Section 3 That there is hereby annually appropriated from the Borough Treasury all such sum or sums of mody that may hereafter be paid into the aforesaid Borough Treasury by the Treasurer of the State of Pennsylvania, on account of taxes paid or premiums by foreign fire insurance companies in pursuance to an Act of Assembly in such case made and provided.

Section 4 All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 30

Providing for the levying and collecting for the year 1932 of a twelve mill tax for general borough purposes.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Borough of New Milford, County of Susquehanna and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same., That there shall be levied and collected for the year 1932, for general borough purposes, a tax of twelve mills on the dollar, or one dollar and twenty cents per one hundred dollars, on the assessed valuation for county purposes.
