

ORDINANCE NO. 73

Regulating parking in certain streets in the Borough of New Milford, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania.

The Borough of New Milford, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains:

1. Definition and construction, The definitions contained in "The Vehicle Code" shall apply to this ordinance.
2. Parking is prohibited in the designated portions of the following streets:
 - (a) On the east side of Church Street from the intersection of curb lines of Broad Street to the intersection of curblines of Park Place Street.
 - (b) On the west side of Church Street from the intersection of the south curb line of Pratt Street to the intersection of the north curb line of Jackson Street.
3. Penalties: Any person violating any provisions of this ordinance upon receiving notice of said violation by ticker, either handed to him in person, or placed upon his windshield under his windshield wiper by any police officer of the Borough of New Milford, may pay a fine of two dollars to the Magistrate designated in said ticket within five days of the date stated on said notice, and in the event of a failure of any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance to apy said fine of two dollars within five days of the date stated on said notice as aforesaid, any person biolating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon summary conviction before a magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than two dollars nor more than ten dollars and costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment thereof shall undergo imprisonment for not more than five days.
4. All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed..
