

ORDINANCE NO. 21

An ordinance providing for the payment of a licence tax for operating pool-room or billiard-room within the Borough of New Milford; fixing the time of opening and closing the same and prescribing penalties for violation of this ordinance. Be it ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of New Milford, County of Susquehanna and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same;

Section 1 That hereafter no pool-room or billiard-room shall be opened or operated within the Borough of New Milford unless a license to operate same shall be obtained from the Council of the Borough of New Milford.

Section 2 That the fee for obtaining such license shall be Ten Dollars per annum for each table, pool or billiard, operated in such pool or billiard room.

Section 3 That such pool and billiard room shall not be open for business or operation earlier than 7 o'clock A.M., on every secular or week day and shall close not later than 11:30 o'clock P.M., on every secular or week day, and that under no circumstance shall any such pool or billiard-room be conducted on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday.

Section 4 That the license provided for in Section 1 of this ordinance shall be obtained from the Burgess of the Borough of New Milford and under the seal of said Borough, and that the license shall not be subject to rebate, nor shall a license be granted for any period of time less than one (1) year.

Section 5 That any person violating the terms of this ordinance shall be subjected to the following fines: For operating such pool or billiard-room at any time other than during the hours permitted by the terms hereof, Ten (\$10.00) Dollars for each such offense; For operating any such pool or billiard-room on Sunday in violation thereof Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars. Such fines to be recovered at a suit of the Borough against the violator hereof.
