

AN ORDINANCE

PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF A VEHICLE ON ANY PORTION OF A TOWNSHIP ROAD OR HIGHWAY, IMPROVED, DESIGNED OR ORDINARILY USED BY VEHICULAR TRAVEL, EXCLUSIVE OF BERM OR SHOULDER, WITH CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Lenox, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania, that:

SECTION I: From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any owner or operator of any vehicle to permit the parking of a vehicle on any portion of a Township Road or Highway, improved, designed or ordinarily used for vehicular travel, exclusive of the berm or shoulder or to park any vehicle in any manner which interferes with vehicular travel, snow removal and maintenance of Township Roads or Highways; subject to the exception of certain types of vehicles and uses as set forth in Section II hereof.

SECTION II: Section I of this Ordinance shall not apply to police or fire department vehicles or ambulances or vehicles being used for the purpose of road construction when construction is in progress on that road whether occupied or not or to vehicles temporarily parked for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading.

SECTION III: Any person violating or causing this Ordinance to be violated shall upon conviction thereof, pay a fine or penalty according to the PA. Vehicle Code fine schedule, together with costs of prosecution to be collected as other fines and penalties are by law collected.

SECTION IV: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
