AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF THE ROAD KNOWN AS ROUTE 671 IN THOMPSON TOWNSHIP SUSQUEHANNA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

The Township of Thompson hereby, ordains and enacts, as follows:

THAT a certain road being a section of Route 671, and lying between the farms of I. L. Buck on the east, and John Bauman on the west, being approximately nine-tenths (9/10) of a mile, is useless, burdensome, and unnecessary for the convenience of the travelling public.

THAT the said section of the highway known as Route 671 between the farms of I. L. Buck on the east, and the farm of John Bauman, formerly of Joseph Sienkiewicz, on the west, being approximately nine-tenths (9/10) of a mile is hereby abandoned and vacated.
