Items that we are able to recycle are...

## **Plastic Bottles**

Must be a Bottle

Must have a 1 or 2

Examples include water bottles, soda bottles, detergent bottles, shampoo bottles, milk bottles, etc.

## **Glass Bottles & Jars**

Must be a bottle or jar that contained food or beverage.

Sorted by color: Brown, Clear and Green.

## **Cardboard**

Dry Corrugated Cardboard Only

Please, break down your boxes.

## **Tin Cans**

Vegetable & Soup Cans

Labels and lids are ok



## **Aluminum Cans**

Soda & Beer Cans



## **Mixed Paper**

Items that are made entirely of paper such as: office paper, newspaper, magazines, cereal boxes, soda cases, phone books, etc.

Must be dry.



## **Scrap Metal items are accepted Monday-Friday, 8am-4pm.**

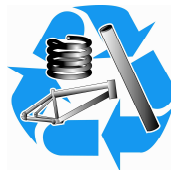
Please, remove all gas/oil.

Air Conditioners—\$15



Scrap metal items must be approved by staff.

No plastic tubs, No plastic bags, No plastic trays, No styro-foam, No ice cream cartons, No milk cartons, No hard-covered books, No laptops, No computers, No printers, No televisions, No wood items, No dishes, No ceramics, No vases, No drinkware, No lightbulbs, No windows, No candles, No tissues, No paper towels, No diapers
