ORDINANCE

VACATING A PORTION OF PROSPECT STREET AND H-L STREET, AND VACATING THE ENTIRETY OF M STREET AND J STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF SUSQUEHANNA DEPOT

Be it hereby ordained and enacted by the Borough of Susquehanna Depot, Susquehanna, Pennsylvania, that from and after the effective date of the within ordinance, which shall be forty days after the passage hereof, those streets and portions of those streets, as follows, shall be deemed vacated:

- 1. Prospect Street, from a point on the westerly edge of Center Lane westerly for a distance of 530 feet to a point near the edge of a ravine or gulley, said point also being in line with the westerly sideline of Lot 171 as laid out by Thomas V. Cook as the property of Sedate Griswold Estate, for the full width of 60 feet of the said agreet.
- 2. That certain street known as $\underline{\text{M Street}}$, from a point on the southerly side of Prospect Street a distance of 240 feet southerly to the northerly edge of that certain street known as H-L Street, for the full width of 50 feet of the said street.
- 3. That certain street known as $\underline{\text{H-L Street}}$, from a point 56 feet westerly from the intersection of the said H-L Street with the extension of Center Lane, a/k/a O-I Street, westerly for a distance of 638 feet to a point on line of lands of Clarence Chamberlain, now or formerly, for the full width of 50 feet of the said street.
- 4. That certain street known as <u>J Street</u>, from a point on the southerly edge of H-L Street a distance of 240 feet southerly to a point opposite the southeasterly corner of lot 208 as laid down on map of Thomas V. Cook of Sedate Griswold Estate lands, for the full width of 50 feet of the said Street.
