

ORDINANCE NO. 67

Annexing to the Borough of New Milford, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania, a Section of the New Milford Township, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania.

Whereas a majority in number of all freeholders of lands in a section of New Milford Township, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania, adjacent to the Borough of New Milford, herein described have petitioned the Corporate authorities of the Borough of New Milford, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania, to annex to said Borough by ordinance said section herein described now, therefore:

SECTION 1

Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Borough Council of the Borough of New Milford, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that pursuant to the petition of a majority in number of all freeholders of the territory proposed to be annexed to the Borough of New Milford, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania, that portion of New Milford Township, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania, adjacent to said Borough and decreibed as follows:

Beginning at a point in the easterly line of the said Borough of New Milford, at a point 2500 feet woutherly from the northeast corner thereof; thence south 82 degrees east 535 feet to a corner; thense south 10 degrees east 2730 feet to an angle; thence south 50 degrees east 1466 feet to a corner of Harry Hall's land; thence along said land south 33 degrees west 660 feet to the center of the road leading to Jackson; thence along land of Leon VanCott, South 33 degrees west 798 feet to a corner at the end of a stone wall; thence through lands of Edward Abbott, north 62 degrees 45 minutes west 1470 feet to a corner in the orginal Borough Line; thence along the same north 4 degrees west 4322 feet to the place of beginning; be annexed, admitted and added, and the same is hereby annexed, admitted and added to the Borough of New Milford as a part and portion of the said Borough of New Milford in accordance with the prayer of the said petitioners and that the same, upon compliance with legal requirements, be subject to the jurisdiction of the authorities of said Borough and shall be entitled to the privileges of the same.

SECTION 2

That the Solicitor of said Borough, Robert G. Dean, be and is hereby authorized and directed to file in the Court of Quarter Sessions of Susquehanna County, a certified copy of this Ordinance together with descriptions and a plot showing the courses and distances of the boundaries of the Borough of New Milford before and after such proposed annexation. Said solicitor is further authorized and directed to file in the office of the Susquehanna County Board of Elections a notice of said filing.

SECTION NO. 3

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed..
