## ORDINANCE # 79-3 - SECRETARY - TREASURER COMBINATION

An ordinance combining the offices of Secretary and Treasurer of the Borough of Hop Bottom and defining the duties and powers thereof.

The Borough of Hop Bottom hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.

"Secretary" - that officer specified in Section 1111 of the Borough Code, 53 P.S. 46111, and hereby invested with all the powers, duties and responsibilities thereof as set forth in that Section;

"Treasurer" - that officer specified in Section 1106 of the Borough Code, 53 P.S. 46106, and hereby invested with all the powers, duties and responsibilities thereof as set forth in that section.

SECTION 2. COMBINATION OF OFFICES.

The offices of Secretary and Treasurer of the Bonough of Hop Bottom are hereby authorized to be held by the same person, pursuant to Section 1104 of the Bonough Code, 53 P.S. 46104.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect January 1, 1980.
