

ORDINANCE NO. 136

AN ORDINANCE OPPOSING SENATE BILL NO. 1 CALLED THE  
"PENNSYLVANIA FLOOD DISASTER PREVENTION ACT"

WHEREAS, THE Borough Council of New Milford are in favor of Flood Disaster prevention; and

WHEREAS, local ordinance can meet all Federal requirements to qualify for Federal Flood Insurance; and;

WHEREAS, proposed State Legislation titled, "Senate Bill #1" called the "Pennsylvania Flood Disaster Prevention Act" would negate the municipality's present Flood Plain Ordinance and mandate instead a state land use zoning plan; and

WHEREAS, the Local Government Officials are more attuned to the needs of the community and more aware of local needs and consideration for use of land; therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Council do here this 6th day of November 1975 call upon the State Legislature to OPPOSE SENATE BILL #1; and be it further

RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be transmitted to State Senator Newell Wood and Representative Carmel Sirianni.
