

ORDINANCE NUMBER 87-1

REGULATING THE ACCUMULATION, STORING
AND DUMPING OF GARBAGE AND REFUSE

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ACCUMULATION, DUMPING,
STORAGE OR BURYING OF GARBAGE, RUBBISH AND REFUSE
IN THE TOWNSHIP OF ARARAT ON PRIVATE LANDS AND
PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

The Ararat Board of Supervisors, Susquehanna County,
Pennsylvania hereby ordain as follows:

No person, association, firm or corporation shall keep, store or suffer to remain upon his or her premises, or on any private property, which is not a duly licensed landfill operating in full compliance with a valid permit from the Pennsylvania D.E.R. and in full compliance with the licensing requirements of Ararat Township, any garbage, rubbish or refuse or other offensive or unwholesome matter, or cast the same upon any lot or piece of ground within the Township of Ararat as a public or private dump or burial ground of garbage, refuse or rubbish. Any person, firm or corporation who or which shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Five Hundred (\$500.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days. Provided: Each day's continuance of a violation shall constitute a separate offense.
